## Complaint Description

### Details:

Urgent Complaint Regarding Probation Officer Conduct - Rockenhaus, Conrad

Dear OIG,

I am writing to formally complain about the conduct of my husband's probation officer, Stylianos Agapiou, in relation to his supervised release for his case.

On Tuesday, November 19, 2024, Officer Agapiou contacted me by phone.

He harshly demanded information about computer devices at the web development company I own, where my husband is employed.

His tone was extremely aggressive and hostile, especially concerning given that I had just been released from the hospital yesterday following a concussion.

My husband, very aware of my medical condition, had specifically requested that Officer Agapiou delay any contact with me until I had recovered further.

Despite this request, Officer Agapiou proceeded to call me with instant hostility.

We also have footage on our Video Doorbell that shows he attempted to enter our residence without permission when the doorbell wasn't immediately answered.

This unauthorized attempt to enter our residence has caused us serious concern and has left me feeling deeply unsafe in my own home.

Officer Agapiou's behavior threats were particularly egregious given that I am not under any form of criminal investigation or supervision. He threatened to:

\* Confiscate my personal and work computers: This threat was completely unfounded, as I have no involvement in my husband's case and have never been accused of any wrongdoing.

\* Initiate a raid on our home: He made this threat because he felt I was not answering his questions to his satisfaction, despite being fully aware of my recent concussion and ongoing cognitive difficulties.

\* Have me arrested: This was an outrageous and baseless threat, considering I have no criminal history and am a law-abiding citizen. His unprofessional behavior was deeply disrespectful and frankly, shocking.

His words and aggressive demeanor made me fear for my safety and well-being.

As a woman with autism, this experience has been particularly distressing, leaving me unable to feel secure in my own home.

I am now fearful of remaining at my residence due to the possibility of further unannounced and potentially hostile visits from this officer.

I respectfully request that the Office of the Inspector General investigate this matter thoroughly and take appropriate action to address Officer Agapiou's misconduct.

I am available to provide a copy of the video doorbell footage and any further information needed for your investigation.

I also request that my husband be assigned a new probation officer to ensure his supervision continues without further incident and to alleviate my concerns for my safety.

Thank you for your time and attention to this urgent matter.
